Current Status of MGNREGA Finances in Andhra Pradesh(AP)

About this report

This report was prepared using data available in the public domain. The period of study for all analysis was from April to 15th November, 2021. This report is an analysis of MGNREGA Budget vs expenditure for the current FY. We hope that the report contributes to improving the implementation of MGNREGA in Andhra Pradesh.

Money Matters:

1. What is the budget allocation for Andhra Pradesh under MGNREGA for the current FY (2021-22) when compared to last FY (2020-21)? The budget allocation for MGNREGA for the current FY is Rs.6271.7 crores. The revised allocation for FY 2020-21 was Rs 10365.5 crores. There is a 39.5% decrease in the budget allocation this FY compared to last FY.

2. How much money of the initial allocation for MGNREGA implementation in AP is left this current year?

There is no amount left for the remaining FY 2021-22 as the allocated budget has not only been exhausted, but over spent. Out of Rs6271.7 crores allocated, Rs7379.9 crores has already been spent(Refer Table 2). For District-wise detailed expenditure breakup please refer Annexure 3.

3. Is the original budget allocation for the current FY for Andhra Pradesh enough? No, the original allocation was greenly inadequate. The allocated budget got

No, the original allocation was grossly inadequate. The allocated budget got exhausted within just 7 months of the financial year with 5 months remaining is a testimony to this. Now the state has been left with no money for the remaining four and half months for MGNREGA implementation.

4. What is the current status of MGNREGA finances in Andhra Pradesh?

Out of the original allocation of Rs6271.7 crores, the Centre has released Rs4571.2 crores so far but the state has already spent Rs7379.9 crores. Therefore, the MGNREGA-AP budget has a negative balance of Rs2808.7 crores.

5. How much more budget do we need for the remaining time period?

If we estimate similar employment as last year for the remaining 4.5 months, additional allocation of 1782.09 Cr (Annexure1) is required. But if we consider providing 100 days of work as guaranteed by the act, the state would need a whooping Rs.9203.26 Cr (Annexure2). This includes wage, material and admin expenditure.

6. What will be the impact of funds crunch on the MGNREGA implementation in AP?

With no money left in the coffers, workers might not receive any more employment under MGNREGA till March 2022. On top of it the workers would have to wait to receive the 416 Cr pending wages for the works already completed. The situation can be averted if the central government allocates additional funds for the implementation and releases them immediately.
